

Food and Snack Policy

Pretzels, water, cups, and napkins are available for classes. You'll find these in the Carriage House Workroom and in the Hollin Hall supply closet. If you'd prefer juice, please the RE Assistant know and we'll purchase it for your class.

If a lesson in your curriculum calls for specific food as part of a lesson, let us know what you plan to use and we'll provide it for you.

RE is not budgeted to provide regular snacks or meals – other than pretzels and juice – to classes. As an occasional treat, we can provide a special snack for your class. Pretzels, water and juice may sound kind of bleak, but most of our kids are used to - and expect - it and many actually look forward to it.

If anything other than pretzels or water is provided, be sure to check your class attendance folder for food allergies.

Please be aware of the RE peanut and nut policy:

“The Religious Education Program maintains a peanut- and tree nut-free environment in all RE-related activities.

The following are prohibited from use in any RE-related activity:

- peanuts or tree nuts
- products containing peanuts or tree nuts
- products containing or prepared with the oil of peanuts or tree nuts
- products containing traces of peanuts or tree nuts

Persons bringing, preparing or using food products for RE-related activities *must* carefully check the ingredients lists of *all* foods to ensure they do not contain peanut or tree nuts or their derivatives. “
