

Guidelines for Church and Congregational Activities During the COVID19 Pandemic
Adopted by the MVUC Board of Trustees August 11, 2020
Updated per new Commonwealth of Virginia Guidelines December 10, 2020
Based on Recommendations from the MVUC COVID19 Task Force

Current as of December 10, 2020

1. **Sunday Services** will continue to be held online through May 2021
2. **Outside meetings** on church property can be held provided the following criteria are met
 - a. Maximum of 10 people – **NEW as of December 10, 2020**
 - b. A minimum of 6 feet of distancing between people
 - c. Facial coverings that cover the nose and mouth must be worn
 - d. Chairs will not be set up
 - e. Participants should bring their own individual food and utensils
 - f. There should be no shared food or common drinks
3. Types of outside events/meetings that are currently allowed
 - a. Memorials
 - b. Church sponsored events/meetings
 - c. No rentals at least until end of 2020
4. **Indoor meetings** can be held provided they meet the following criteria
 - a. Maximum of 10 people
 - b. A minimum of 6 feet of distancing between people
 - c. Facial coverings that cover the nose and mouth must be worn
 - d. Only one group in the Meeting House and one group in Hollin Hall at the same time are allowed.
 - e. Rest room use only in Hollin Hall. Rest rooms in the Meeting House are not to be used.
 - i. Windows in restrooms need to be opened before use and closed when meeting is over.
5. Types of indoor meetings that are currently allowed
 - a. Memorials
 - b. Church sponsored events/meetings
 - c. No rentals
