

## **Guidelines for Church and Congregational Activities During the COVID19 Pandemic**

Adopted by the MVUC Board of Trustees August 11, 2020

**Last Updated March 13, 2021**

**Based on Recommendations from the MVUC COVID19 Task Force**

Current as of March 13, 2021

1. **Sunday Services** will continue to be held online through May 2021.
2. Everyone **inside Hollin Hall and the Meeting House** will wear a multi-layer tight fitting mask and continue physical distancing of at least 6 feet. Staff who are alone in their offices with the doors closed are exempt from mask wearing.
3. Those who are **fully vaccinated** are required to wear masks and maintain 6 feet of physical distance from others.
4. **Fort Hunt Preschool** will not have in-person classes until at least April 2021.
5. **Outside and indoor meetings and events** on church property can be held provided the following criteria are met
  - a. For indoor meetings: Maximum of 10 people
  - b. For outdoor meetings: Maximum of 25 people
  - c. A minimum of 6 feet of physical distancing between people at all times
  - d. Facial coverings that cover the nose and mouth must be worn at all times
  - e. Participants should bring their own individual food and utensils
  - f. There should be no shared food or common drinks
  - g. Only one group in the Meeting House and one group in Hollin Hall at the same time are allowed.
  - h. Rest room use only in Hollin Hall. Rest rooms in the Meeting House are not to be used.
    - i. Windows in restrooms need to be opened before use and closed when meeting is over.
6. **Types of outside events/meetings** that are currently allowed
  - a. Memorials
  - b. Church sponsored events/meetings
  - c. No rentals to anyone other than Alcoholics Anonymous
