

Recommendations from MVUC COVID Task Force to MVUC's Board of Trustees (March 3, 2022)

1. Indoor Meetings

- a. Resume all indoor meetings
 - i. Can meet indoors starting March 15th
 - ii. Capacity: 100 people in the Sanctuary, 30 people in the Commons
 - iii. Capacity: Hollin Hall Fireplace Room 25 people
 - iv. Capacity: Hollin Hall Dining Room, 25 people
 - v. **Fully-masked N95, KN95 or KF94 only, no cloth masks**
 - vi. Maintain six feet distance
 - vii. A family household can sit together
 - viii. No food or drinks are allowed
 - ix. Only people who are fully vaccinated and boosted may attend
 - x. Children who have had two vaccines, but are not eligible for a booster may attend indoor meetings/services
 - xi. Vaccination cards will not be checked. People will be asked to not go indoors if they are not fully vaccinated and boosted
 - xii. Singing indoors is allowed while wearing K 94 or K95 masks
 - xiii. Children under 5 are not allowed indoors. They can be outdoors
 - xiv. Dan will write an announcement for the Weekly Newsletter about safety measures at MVUC

2. Outdoor Meetings

- a. Resume outdoor meetings
- b. Allow only people who are fully vaccinated and boosted to meet outdoors
- c. Social distancing is recommended
- d. Masks are optional
- e. A family household can sit together
- f. Food or drinks are allowed.
- g. Singers may sing outside; no mask is required

3. Ft. Hunt Preschool

Ft. Hunt Preschool can resume classes inside the Carriage House following state and county guidelines

4. A **Child Dedication** can be in-person with immediate family members, and a small number of other family and MVUC officiants, volunteers. Other than immediate family members of the baby, it is recommended others have a negative COVID test within 3 days of the service. This is for protection of the child.
