

**Recommendations from MVUC COVID Task Force to
MVUC's Board of Trustees (June 28th, 2022)
Approved by Board of Trustees July 12, 2022**

Indoor and outdoor MVUC meetings/events/services may resume with no age restrictions

- A. Indoor Meetings – Guidance below applies to all indoor activities, services, meetings, child dedications, funerals, etc.:
 - I. Adults and children may meet indoors for services or other MVUC activities as long as they comply with Personal Care Requirements for Employees, Congregants, Friends and Visitors, dated June 28th, 2022 (see separate document).
 - II. Capacity: 100 people in the Sanctuary, 30 people in the Commons, 25 people in Hollin Hall Fireplace Room and Dining Room
 - III. Only individuals who are fully vaccinated & boosted (unless medically contraindicated by their physician) may attend.
 - IV. Individuals not yet eligible for boosters, but who have completed their primary series of vaccines (2 shots for adults/2 or 3 shots for children 6 months and above), may attend.
 - V. Individuals attending services/activities will not be asked for proof of vaccination
 - VI. All individuals must wear N95, KN95 or KF94 facemasks. Cloth masks are not permitted.
 - VII. MVUC will provide a supply of these masks near the entrances to the meeting house and Hollin Hall, for those who do not bring their own masks.
 - VIII. Individuals are encouraged to maintain six feet distance when possible.
 - IX. Family households and groups of friends may sit together if they wish.
 - X. Food or drinks are not allowed, though the kitchen may open to provide drinks/snacks for outdoor consumption.
 - XI. Singing indoors is allowed while wearing appropriate facemasks.
 - XII. Speakers may remove facemasks when speaking from the podium.
 - XIII. Playing of wind and brass instruments is not permitted at this time.

- B. Outdoor Meetings:
 - I. Only people who are fully vaccinated and boosted, as above, may attend.
 - II. Social distancing is recommended.
 - III. Wearing of facemasks is recommended for those who are medically vulnerable.
 - IV. A family household or groups of friends may sit together.
 - V. Consumption of food and drinks is permitted.
 - VI. Singers/musicians may perform outside but must stand 12 feet apart from attendees.

- C. Ft. Hunt Preschool may resume classes following state/county guidelines.
