

FACT SHEET

THE MEMORIAL WALKS OF THE MOUNT VERNON UNITARIAN CHURCH

The operations of the Memorial Walks are largely self-supporting. Costs are met chiefly from fees for memorialization services. Management is provided by the Memorial Walks Committee of the Mount Vernon Unitarian Church under the oversight of the Board of Trustees. The fee structure set forth below is intended to ensure the success of The Memorial Walks on a long-term basis. The fees cited are necessary (a) to the continuing enhancement and expansion of the memorial facilities and (b) to the preservation of The Memorial Walks in perpetuity.

FEE STRUCTURE

1. Interment of ashes plus name on Memorial Plaque: \$2400

The interment of ashes is done so that the ashes are returned to the earth by burial in the earth below a nameplate in the Columbarium.

2. Name on Memorial Plaque only: \$650

Option used chiefly in cases where family traditions call for burial elsewhere.

TYPES OF PARTICIPATION

1. Those wishing to memorialize a loved one already deceased can arrange to have that person's name (with birth and death dates) placed on a Memorial Plaque for the requisite fee of \$650. If the person's ashes are available, they can be interred as well for a combined fee of \$2400. The church, for its part, will handle the details of memorialization and maintain the memorial facilities throughout their existence.
2. Those wishing to arrange in advance for the occasion of their own death can, by prepayment direct the church upon notification of their death to place their name on the Memorial Plaque and inter their ashes in the columbarium. The same advance arrangements can be made for other immediate family members.
3. Individuals may be memorialized on a Memorial Plaque irrespective of where their remains are interred.

RECORDS MAINTAINED

Biographical information provided by an individual or family is kept on file in the church office.
